#### Trustees' Annual Report Year ended 31 December 2016

#### Structure, Governance and Management

#### **Governing Document**

The Church is administered in accordance with the terms of the Deed of Constitution. The Deed of Constitution was of the Quoad Sacra form until 17<sup>th</sup> August 2016. From 17<sup>th</sup> August 2016, by Delegation of the General Assembly, the Deed of Constitution (Unitary Form) applies.

#### **Recruitment and Appointment of Trustees**

Until 17<sup>th</sup> august 2016, members of the Kirk Session and the Congregational Board were charity trustees. From 17<sup>th</sup> August 2016, members of the Kirk Session are the charity trustees. Member ship of Kirk Session is constituted of the elders and minister.

Elders can be appointed in three ways. These are

- 1) nomination and direct election by members of the congregation;
- 2) a system of signed lists, in which members of the congregation submit a signed list of names. The names having the greatest number of votes are elected;
- 3) nomination and appointment by the Kirk Session

#### **Organisational Structure**

The Kirk Session has oversight of the whole life and service of the Church within its Parish; responsibility for the spiritual and temporal oversight of the Congregation's affairs. The Kirk Session also delegates certain areas of its work to committees and may also appoint members and non members of the congregation to serve on such committees. Committees operate within the remit granted to them by Kirk Session.

#### **Objectives and Activities**

The Church of Scotland is Trinitarian in doctrine, Reformed in tradition and Presbyterian in polity. It exists to glorify God and to work for the advancement of Christ's Kingdom throughout the world. As a national Church, it acknowledges a distinctive call and duty to bring the ordinances of religion to the people in every parish in Scotland through a territorial ministry. It co-operates with other Churches in various ecumenical bodies in Scotland and beyond.

#### **Achievements and Performance**

**Sunday worship** – In our parish of North Knapdale we rotate our Sunday worship between the churches within the three communities which serve the wider are of North Knapdale; Tayvallich, Inverlussa and Bellanoch.

Being aware of the changing pattern of worship, we are forging strong links with the community through our Cafe Connect initiative; meeting every Saturday in Achnamara Village Hall. We also run Messy Church in this Parish and in association with our linked parish. Messy church continues to be popular and well supported.

Both of these activities are excellent forms of outreach to the wider community.

**Christmas Cards.** We organise a Christmas card design competition in partnership with the Primary School in our parish. The best design is printed and then delivered to every home in the parish. The cards contain details of all our Advent and Christmas events. The outreach helps to maintain a vital link with many in our community who ar not church members, but appreciate a caring message from the church and the opportunity for worship at this special time of year.

**Members of our congregation** are actively involved in a wide variety of community groups and societies.

#### **Financial Review**

The principal source of income is weekly offerings (86%). The annual income has decreased by 14% over last year, 3% as a result of deferring the small gift aid claim. Expenditure has increased by 8% this year. This does not include maintenance costs which were funded from the consolidated fabric funds.

#### **Reserves Policy**

It is the Trustees' policy to hold reserves of approximately nine months expenditure including designated funds. At the year end the Church held unrestricted cash funds of £38431. This represents approximately nine months' expenditure.

#### Statement of Trustees' Responsibilities

The members of the Kirk Session / Congregational Board must prepare financial statements which give sufficient detail to enable an appreciation of the transactions of the Church during the financial year. The members of the Kirk Session / Congregational Board are responsible for keeping proper accounting records which, on request, must reflect the financial position of the Church at that time. This must be done to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005, the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 and the Regulations Anent Congregational Finance approved by the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland in 2007. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the Church and must take reasonable steps for the prevention and/or detection of fraud and other irregularities.

### Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of North Knapdale Parish Church of Scotland

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31 December 2016 which are set out on pages 5 to 9.

#### Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006.

The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1) (d) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section 44(1) (c) of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

#### Basis of independent examiner's statement

An examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

#### Independent examiner's statement
