Structure, Governance and Management

Governing Document

The Church is administered in accordance with the terms of the Deed of Constitution (Unitary Form).

Recruitment and Appointment of Trustees

Members of the Kirk Session are the charity trustees. Membership of Kirk Session is constituted of the elders and minister.

Elders can be appointed in three ways. These are

- 1) nomination and direct election by members of the congregation;
- 2) a system of signed lists, in which members of the congregation submit a signed list of names. The names having the greatest number of votes are elected:
- 3) nomination and appointment by the Kirk Session

Organisational Structure

The Kirk Session has oversight of the whole life and service of the Church within its Parish; responsibility for the spiritual and temporal oversight of the Congregation's affairs. The Kirk Session also delegates certain areas of its work to committees and may also appoint members and non members of the congregation to serve on such committees. Committees operate within the remit granted to them by Kirk Session.

Objectives and Activities

The Church of Scotland is Trinitarian in doctrine, Reformed in tradition and Presbyterian in polity. It exists to glorify God and to work for the advancement of Christ's Kingdom throughout the world. As a national Church, it acknowledges a distinctive call and duty to bring the ordinances of religion to the people in every parish in Scotland through a territorial ministry. It co-operates with other Churches in various ecumenical bodies in Scotland and beyond.

Achievements and Performance

Services are held weekly in Tayvallich with occasional joint service in Kilmartin with our linked parish of Glassary, Kilmartin and Ford. We also hold United Services monthly in one of the five Mid Argyll parishes.

The weekly outreach cafe in Achnamara recommenced in the summer of 2021 and is very popular with the community. Second Sunday Supper Outreach meals have restarted.

The weekly zoom prayer meeting continued for several months but is now taking a break. Housegroup continues in the winter months with walks in the summer.

At Easter all the elders submitted a short word of encouragement which was then made into cards by the treasurer. The Easter card was widely distributed.

Members of our congregation are actively involved in a wide variety of Community groups and initiatives. Some of these have met on zoom, hosted by the church zoom account. Members of our congregation were instrumental in organising a very successful Platinum Jubilee event.

Financial Review

One third of our income is from standing orders and envelopes, one third from the offerings and one third from Gift Aid and donations. The annual income has increased by £2,000 due to there being services almost every week. The expenses have risen by £4,000 due to increased fabric spending. Some funds were raised at the Platinum Jubilee event. Significant fabric expenses were reclaimed from our revenue account this year in respect of 2021 as well as 2022.

Reserves Policy

It is the Trustees' policy to hold reserves of approximately nine months expenditure including designated funds. At the year end the Church held unrestricted cash funds of £18,898.08.

Statement of Trustees' Responsibilities

The members of the Kirk Session / Congregational Board must prepare financial statements which give sufficient detail to enable an appreciation of the transactions of the Church during the financial year. The members of the Kirk Session are responsible for keeping proper accounting records which, on request, must reflect the financial position of the Church at that time. This must be done to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005, the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 and the Regulations Anent Congregational Finance approved by the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland in 2007. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the Church and must take reasonable steps for the prevention and/or detection of fraud and other irregularities.
